

Girls, boys sweep Wauseon, Swanton

LUCKEY — Eastwood High School's girls and boys track and field teams both swept a non-conference tri-meet Tuesday (April 7).

The girls won nine of the 17 events and scored 104 points to finish ahead of Wauseon with 52 and Swanton with 19.

The boys won eight events and totaled 83 points to beat Wauseon with 69 and Swanton with 23.

GIRLS RECAP

Camille Foos won twice for Eastwood, and Piper Sutton won the pole vault with the eighth-best jump in school history.

Foos, a junior, won the 200 in 28.88 and cleared 4-10 to win the high jump.

Sutton had height of 9-6 in the pole vault to move into a three-way tie for eighth place on the Eagles' all-time list. She entered the meet in 10th place, thanks to a vault of 9-4 last season.

Eastwood's other individual winners were: junior Josie Appelhans, 100, 12.5 (hand timed); sophomore Kylie Mathia, 800, 2:48.91; and sophomore Karissa Nelson, 100 hurdles, 17.38.

The Eagles' winning relay teams were:

- 4x100 — sophomore Macy Shoemaker, Appelhans, sophomore Lauren Schuerman and Foos, 51.63.
- 4x400 — freshman Gracyn Reiter, sophomore Sophie Gillespie, Schuerman and freshman Ava Majzun, 4:30.13.
- 4x800 — freshman Katelin Russell, junior Brynn Sheets, senior Caitlyn Stiner and junior Raegan Russell, 11:06.80.

Senior Jenna Gallant tied her seated school record in the shot put with a throw of 9-8¼. She first threw 9-8¼ last season.

BOYS RECAP

Six different individuals won one event each for the Eagles, who also won two relays.

Eastwood's Hunter Lauer won the discus with a throw of 157-9, increasing his fifth-best distance in school history. The senior moved into fifth place all-time in the event Thursday (April 2) with a throw of 157-3 at the Liberty-Benton Invitational.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: senior Austin Miller, 400, 52.18; junior Ben Buehler, 800, 2:12.53; senior Henry Howard, 1,600, 4:55.10; sophomore Brayden Luidhardt, 110 hurdles, 16.45; and senior Cullen Shank, pole vault, 11-6.

Eastwood won two relays.

The 4x400 team of Carsyn Jones, Howard, Buehler and Miller won in 3:40.71.

The 4x800 team of Howard, junior Casen Henline, and freshmen Cole Schimoeller and Trent Snyder won in 8:56.92.
