

Middle school girls, boys finish second at Woodmore

ELMORE — Eastwood Middle School's girls and boys track and field teams both finished second Friday in the Woodmore Invitational.

The meet was Eastwood's first in two years after the 2020 season was canceled because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

The girls scored 73 points to finish behind champion Margaretta with 88.

Eastwood's Addison Hartman won the long jump with a distance of 13-6, and Mallory Sandberg won the 200 hurdles in 35.2.

In the boys meet, Eastwood scored 106 points to finish second behind Oak Harbor with 122.

Eastwood's Dayquan Oliver won the long jump with a distance of 18-4.
