Eagles excited to compete in state indoor meet

Eastwood High School is returning to the state indoor track and field meet this weekend.

The Division II-III state meet is Saturday at the Spire Institute in Geneva.

The field events start at noon, followed by the running events at 2 p.m.

The state indoor meet comes after two weeks after the start of practice for the outdoor season. Eastwood's weekly indoor schedule started Dec. 19, consisting of three meets and five practices. One practice was

canceled because of snow.

Eastwood had no indoor season in 2021 because of COVID.

The state meet is conducted by the Ohio Association of Track, and Cross-Country Coaches.

"I am excited for our athletes to have the opportunity to compete in this caliber of a meet with the tough competition," Eagle girls head coach Nikki Sabo said. "Having this experience will give them confidence going into the outdoor season."

"I am excited to have an indoor state meet again," Eastwood boys head coach Brian Sabo said. "Our OATCCC does a fantastic job making it seem like a state meet. The competition is usually pretty outstanding. It is also fun to go to some different events like the triple jump and the weight throw. For the field events especially, it allows you practice and trials early in the season because March can be very hard to get quality work done outside."

The Eagles still have three weeks of outdoor practice remaining before their first meet March 29 at Oak Harbor.

"We had no indoor season last year, so this was very new to so many people," Brian Sabo said. "Having an indoor season and now rolling into the first two weeks of outdoor practice, we are so much further ahead of 2021. We were very young last year with outstanding senior leadership. What we are already seeing, besides improvement, is less teaching new or basic things. Now, we are progressing onto more techniques you do with experienced people. I am really pumped for the season and seeing how this family grows."

"Spire's facility is one of the best in America and for the kids to compete at such a facility is a thrill for them," Nikki Sabo said. "Spire hosted the Big Ten Indoor Championships just this past weekend and for our kids to race on a 300-meter track indoors with the finest facilities will cap off our already successful indoor season."
