

Girls win opening three-team meet; boys finish third

WAUSEON — Eastwood High School's girls track and field team won its season-opening meet Tuesday against host Wauseon and Clay.

The Eagles scored 64 points to edge runner-up by Clay two and finish ahead of third-place Clay with 46.

The Eastwood boys finished third with 51 points to trail Clay with 71½ and Wauseon with 52¾.

The Eagles won nine of the 17 events, with freshman Lauren Schuerman winning three events and senior Leah Emch winning twice.

Schuerman won the 100 in 13.61 and the 200 in 27.81, and went 15-2¾ to win the long jump.

Emch won the 800 in 2:32.59 and the 1,600 in 5:34.49.

Eastwood's other individual winners were: sophomore Camille Foos, 400, 1:05.21; and senior Emily Payne, 3,200, 13:24.34.

The Eagles won two relays.

The 4x100 team of senior Mallory Sandberg, junior Lilly Hanneman, freshman Macy Shoemaker and Schuerman won in 53.71.

The 4x800 team of sophomore Vanessa Evans, Payne, freshman Kylie Mathia and sophomore Brynn Sheets won 11:26.67.

BOYS RECAP

Eastwood won five events, including two first-place finishes by Dayquan Oliver. The senior won the 100 in 11.29 and the 200 in 23.00.

Eagle junior Cullen Shank and senior Hayden Hoelter tied for first place in the pole vault, clearing 12-6.

Eastwood won two relays.

The 4x800 team of sophomore Ben Buehler, junior Henry Howard, senior A.J. O'Brien and junior Austin Miller won in 8:45.77.

The 4x400 team of Howard, Miller, Hoelter and sophomore Cody Hefflinger won in 3:36.31.
