

Girls, boys beat Rossford in NBC dual

ROSSFORD – Eastwood High School's girls and boys track and field team both defeated Rossford in a Northern Buckeye Conference at the Glenwood Athletic Complex.

The girls won 14 of the 17 events and totaled 117 points to beat Rossford, which scored 20 points. The boys won 11 events in their 92-45 victory.

GIRLS RECAP

Eleven different individuals won for Eastwood, including freshman Camille Foos, who finished first in the 200 and the high jump.

Foos won the 200 in 28.84 and the high jump with a height of 5-0.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: junior Mallory Sandberg, 100 hurdles, 17.84; freshman Brynn Sheets, 1,600, 6:11.9; junior Emerson Sheets, 400, 1:09.38; senior Kayla Buehler, 300 hurdles, 53.18; freshman Raegan Russell, 800, 3:01.9; junior Emily Payne, 3,200, 13:44.3; sophomore Kennedy Ameling, discus, 91-10; senior Reilly Might, long jump, 14-1; freshman Harper Rollins-Morlock, shot put, 29-0; and junior Kyrie Henline, pole vault, 9-0.

Eastwood also won two relays.

The 4x800 team of junior Leah Emch, freshman Keira Dawson, junior Carys Ruck and sophomore Wren Cunningham won in 11:41.8.

The 4x400 team of Emerson, Russell, sophomore Caitlyn Stiner and Payne won in 5:04.6.

Sophomore Jenna Gallant established a school record in the seated 100 m with a time of 40.14 and improved her seated shot put school record to 8 feet 10 inches.

BOYS RECAP

Junior Jesse Poiry and senior Kaiden Sanchez both won twice for Eastwood. Six other Eagles also won one individual event.

Poiry swept the hurdles, winning the 110 race in 16.14 and the 300 race in 43.74.

Sanchez won the 100 in 12.04 and the 200 in 24.74.

Eastwood's other individual winners were: sophomore Henry Howard, 1,600, 5:02.7; junior John Stewart, 3,200, 11:22.8; junior Andre Lewis, 6-1; junior Dayquan Oliver, long jump, 20-7; senior Ian Sibbersen, shot put, 44-10½; and sophomore Cullen Shank, 13-0.

The Eagles also won the 4x800 relay where junior A.J. O'Brien, freshman Ben Buehler, senior Eli Good and freshman Casen Henline won in 9:14.6.
