Mullholand went 16-7½ to win the long jump and won the 200 hurdles in 29.9. Luidhardt cleared 4-10 to win the high jump and won the 110 hurdles in 17.2.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: Hunter Lauer, shot put, 43-10; Braden Dix, discus, 112-6; Cullen Shank, pole vault, 9-3; Wyatt Ashby, 100, 12.8; Casen Henline, 800, 2:55.6; and Collin Brogan, 200, 27.1.

The 4x200 team of Hunter Wilson, Nate Grigson, Bryce Cogger and Dix won in 2:00.3.
