

Middle school girls, boys defeat Maumee

LUCKEY — Eastwood Middle School's girls and boys track and field teams both beat Maumee in a Northern Buckeye Conference dual meet Monday (April 13).

The girls won 10 events on the way to a 76-52 victory. The boys won 12 events in their 93-35 win.

Henline cleared 8-0 to win the pole vault and won the 800 in 2:44.70. Sabo won the 400 in 1:03.57 and the 200 in 29.52.
