

Middle school girls, boys sweep tri-meets

TONTOGANY — Eastwood Middle School's girls and boys track and field teams both swept a tri-meet Monday at Otsego High School.

The girls won 10 events and scored 75 points to defeat Otsego with 30 and North Baltimore with 21.

The boys won 10 events in their 83-49 victory over Otsego. NB didn't score.

Eastwood's Lilly Mullholand won three events in the girls meet, and Kyrie Henline and Leah Emch both won twice.

Mullholand cleared 4-4 to win the high jump, and won the 400 in 1:07.51 and the 200 in 29.76.

Henline won the long jump with a distance of 13-8½ and cleared 8-0 to win the pole vault.

Emch won the 1,600 in 6:00 and the 800 in 2:44.45.

The Eagles' other winners were: Mylie Frantz, shot put, 29-11½; Addison Hartman, discus, 77-9; and the 4x400 relay team of Savannah Stephens, Jordyn Jensen, Makenna Nelson and Mallory Sandberg, 4:52.99.

In the boys meet, Dayquan Oliver and Hayden Hoelter both won twice for the Eagles.

Oliver cleared 5-2 to win the high jump and went 15-8 to win the long jump. Hoelter jumped 8-6 to win the pole vault, and won the 400 in 57.19.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: Hunter Lauer, shot put, 32-0; Braden Dix, discus, 96-9; Jesse Poiry, 100 hurdles, 17-4; Andre Lewis, 200 hurdles, 27.77.

Eastwood also won two relays.

The 4x200 team of Parker Bengry, Kellan Miesmer, Zachary Mullholand and Jason Young won in 1:51.72.

The 4x100 team of Bengry, Miesmer, Ethan Goldsby and Drew Luidhardt won in 53.62.

Eastwood hosts the Northern Buckeye Conference Championships Friday night.
