

Middle school boys, girls beat Maumee

MAUMEE — Eastwood Middle School's boys and girls track and field teams both beat Maumee in a Northern Buckeye Conference dual meet Tuesday.

The boys won 11 of the 16 events on the way to an 87-41 victory. The girls won 12 events in their 77½-50½ win.

BOYS RECAP

Levi Strayer and Max Chaffee each won twice for Eastwood.

Strayer won the 110 hurdles in 17.0 and the 200 hurdles in 28.9. Chaffee threw 131-9½ to win the discus and 41-11 to win the shot.

Hand times were used at this meet for the running events.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: Trent Snyder, 1,600, 5:50.1; Jackson Boninsegna, 200, 27.2; Joshua Young-Bingham, long jump, 14-10¾; and Vincent Opfer, pole vault, 8-6.

Eastwood won three relays:

- 4x800 — Zachary McClure, Michael Richards, Trevor Meronk and Colton Miller, 10:16.2.
- 4x100 — Opfer, Boninsegna, Elijah Wilton and Xander Lauer, 51.7.
- 4x400 — Cole Schimmoeller, Tanner Jensen, McClure and Strayer, 4:14.1.

GIRLS RECAP

Eight different individuals won events for the Eagles. Raegan Sabo was a double-winner for Eastwood, winning the 400 in 1:05.9 and the 200 in 29.5.

Sophie Gillespie won the 200 hurdles. She won her event in 31.5 (FAT time of 31.74).

To convert to FAT (fully automatic timing) The standard conversion from hand time to FAT is to add 0.24 for 100 and 200 meters and by adding 0.18 for races over 300 meters. Sophie is 0.15 seconds away from breaking the school record.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: Emery Wensink, 100 hurdles, 17.7; Macie Bradley, 100, 14.2; Taylor Mangette, 1,600, 6:14.7; Addison Hannan, shot put, 28-5; Gabriella Provo, tie for first/high jump, 4-4; and Kinsley Henline, pole vault, 8-0.

Eastwood won three relays:

- 4x800 — Mangette, A'Ryah Houtz, Lorelei Dulaney and Melody Myers, 11:15.9.
- 4x100 — Bradley, Ellie Caris, Ava Majzun and Sabo, 55.0.
- 4x400 — Provo, Gillespie, Sophie Fiordalisi and Myers, 4:38.8.
