Also for the Eagles, Leah Emch won the 800 in 2:37.90, and Kyrie Henline cleared to 6-0 to win the pole vault.

Eastwood won all three relays.

The 4x200 team of Genson, Piper Sutton, Hoffman and Stephens won in 2:10.70.

The 4x400 team of Jensen, Genson, Emerson Sheets and Emch won in 5:03.

In the boys meet, the Eagles' Kevin Lewis was a triple winner, and Andre Lewis, Hayden Hoelter and Braden Dix were double winners.

Kevin Lewis won the 400 in 1:01.30, the 200 in 26.50 and had a distance of 15-11 to finish first in the long jump.

Andre Lewis swept the hurdles, winning the 110 race in 17.10 and the 200 race in 28.65. Hoelter won the 800 in 2:23 and jumped 8-6 to win the pole vault.

Braden Dix threw 35-8 to win the shot and 119-8 to win the discus.

Also for Eastwood, Dayquan Oliver went 5-4 to win the high jump; the 4x200 relay team of Parker Bengry, Kellan Miesmer, Wyatt Ashby and Jason Young won in 1:53.70; and the 4x400 relay team of Bengry, Zachary Mullholand, Jack Moorman and Jesse Poiry won in 4:16.50.
