

Appelhans breaks 100 record, Schuerman, Miller move up on Top 10 lists in sweep of Genoa, Lake

GENOA — Josie Appelhans broke her school record in the 100, and Lauren Schuerman and Austin Miller moved up on Eastwood High School's track and field all-time Top 10 lists Tuesday (April 14) during the Eagles' sweep of Northern Buckeye Conference rivals Genoa and Lake.

Appelhans, a junior, won the 100 in 12.63 to break her record of 12.68 set last season. Schuerman was second in the 100 in 12.76 to move into fourth place on the Eagles' all-time list in that event. The sophomore entered the meet in a tie for seventh all-time with a time of 12.94 last season.

Miller ran the ninth-fastest time in the 200 in Eastwood history with his first-place time of 22.80. The senior also ran a personal record of 50.48 in winning the 400, beating his previous best of 50.74 last season — the fifth-fastest time in school history. He remained fifth on the 400 list.

Hunter Lauer PRd in the discus with his winning throw of 167-9. He remained fourth on the Eagles' all-time list, but improved his PR of 163-2 at the Whitmer Invitational Friday (April 10). The senior has PRd in the discus in all four of the team's meets this season.

The Eagle girls scored 106½ points to beat Genoa with 35½ and Lake with 33. The boys totaled 93½ points to defeat Lake with 49 and Genoa with 32½. Eastwood won 10 events in each meet.

Appelhans also won the 200 in 26.13 and Schuerman won the 400 in 1:02.18 for the Eagles, who won four individual running events, four field events and two relays.

Eastwood's other individual winners were: freshman Taylor Mangette, 800, 2:42.05; freshman Addison Hannan, discus, 110-6; junior Camille Foos, high jump, 4-10; senior Kennedy Ameling, shot put, 32-2½; and senior Piper Sutton, pole vault, 9-0.

The Eagles won two relays.

The 4x800 team of Mangette, junior Mackenzie Chaffee, freshman Ava Majzun and junior Brynn Sheets won in 10:41.44.

The 4x400 team of freshman Sophie Gillespie, sophomore Karissa Nelson, and freshmen Katelin Russell and Gracyn Reiter won in 4:27.85.

BOYS RECAP

Brayden Luidhardt won twice for the Eagles, who won six individual running events, two relays and two field events. The sophomore swept the hurdles, winning the 110 race in 16.10 and the 300 race in 44.63.

Eastwood's other individual winners were: sophomore Oliver St. Louis, 800, 2:14.95; junior Ben Buehler, 3,200, 11:05.20; and senior Zach Mullholand, long jump, 19-8¼.

The Eagles won two relays.

The 4x800 team of St. Louis, sophomores Scott McKenzie and Jacob Connell, and freshman Trent Snyder won in 9:06.42.

The 4x200 team of Miller, Buehler, senior Henry Howard and junior Casen Henline won in 1:33.85.
