

Middle school boys finish second in Eastwood Relays

Eastwood Middle School's boys track and field team won five events, including a school record in the shot put, to finish second in the Eastwood Relays Thursday night.

The Eagles scored 84 points to edge Oak Harbor by two points for second place. Fremont won the seven-team meet with 104 points.

Eastwood's girls won two events in their meet and were fourth with 68 points.

BOYS RECAP

Hunter Lauer, Braden Dix and Dominic Eckert won the shot with a combined distance of 117-1 to break the Eastwood record of 112-8½ set in 2015.

The field events were scored as relays. Each school entered up to three athletes per event, with the combined distance or height determining the team points.

Lauer finished first individually with a distance of 44-5¾, while Dix was third at 38-4½, and Eckert was eighth at 34-2¾.

Dix, Lauer and Eckert also won the discus, 331-1. Dix was third at 127-6, while Lauer was fourth at 114-9, and Eckert was 10th at 89-2.

The Eagles' other winners were:

- Pole vault: Cullen Shank, Henry Howard and Cam Schumaker, 25-6. Shank was first at 9-0, while Howard was second at 8-6, and Schumaker was in a three-way tie for third at 8-0.
- High jump: Drew Luidhardt, Lauer and Ty Lewis, 14-2. Luidhardt and Lauer were in a three-way tie for first at 5-0, while Lewis was in a three-way tie for ninth at 4-2.
- 4x110 shuttle hurdles: Luidhardt, Steven Nelson, Nolan Taylor and Zachary Mullholand, 1:11.97.

GIRLS RECAP

Eastwood's winners were:

- Pole vault: Makenna Nelson, Piper Sutton and Addison Goodlet, 17-6. Nelson and Sutton tied for third at 6-0, while Goodlet tied for fifth at 5-6.
- Discus: Kennedy Ameling, Caitlyn Stiner and Makenzie Grover, 219-0. Ameling was second at 78-8, while Sinner was second at 76-0, and Grover was third at 64-4.
