

Middle school girls win Dee Clay Invitational, boys finish second

FOSTORIA — Eastwood Middle School's girls track and field team won the Dee Clay Invitational and the boys team finished second Monday.

The girls won seven events and scored 152½ points to edge Fremont by 1½ points in the 10-team meet. The boys won three events and totaled 91 points to trail Fremont with 151 in their nine-team meet.

GIRLS RECAP

Eastwood's Lauren Schuerman and Karissa Nelson each won three events.

Schuerman won the 100 in 13.21 and the 200 in 27.77, and went 14-1¼ to win the long jump. Nelson won both hurdles races, winning the 100 meter race in 17.52 and the 200 meter race in 33.38. She also jumped 7-0 to win the pole vault.

The Eagles' Macy Shoemaker cleared 4-6 to win the high jump.

BOYS RECAP

Brayden Luidhardt won twice for the Eagles. He finished first in the 110 hurdles in 17.00 and the 200 hurdles in 27.76.

Eastwood's Everett Ward won the pole vault, clearing 9-0.
