

Middle school girls, boys beat Rossford

LUCKEY — Eastwood Middle School's girls and boys track and field teams both defeated Rossford Monday.

The girls won 10 events in their 80-43 victory. The boys won 11 events in their 82-41 victory. The Eagles' Mallory Sandberg, Leach Emch and Kyrie Henline all won twice during the girls meet,

Sandberg swept the hurdles. She won the 100 race in 19.93 and the 200 race in 36.04. Emch was first in the 1,600 in 6:04.63 and the 800 in 2:51.23. Henline won the 400 in 1:09.17 and cleared 7-0 to win the pole vault.

Eastwood's other winners were: Addison Hartman, long jump, 13-10; Lilly Mullholand, high jump, 4-6; Taylor Spahn, discus, 65-10; and the 4x400 relay team of Emch, Katelyn Ford, Jade Thornton and Riley Burtchin, 4:57.61.

Dayquan Oliver was a double-winner for Eastwood in the boys meet. He cleared 5-2 to win the high jump and went 17-4½ to win the long jump.

The Eagles' other winners were: Andre Lewis, 110 hurdles, 18.29; Raif Johnson, 1,600, 5:37.55; Kevin Lewis, 400, 1:00.04; Jesse Poiry, 200 hurdles, 29.93; Jack Moorman, 800, 2:36.68; Hayden Hoelter, pole vault, 9-0; Brandon Dix, discus, 104-9; the 4x200 relay team of Parker Bengry, Kellan Miesmer, Wyatt Ashby and Jason Young, 1:53.15; and the 4x400 relay team of Hoelter, Andre Lewis, Oliver and Poiry, 3:58.59.

Eastwood's home meet Wednesday against Woodmore has been moved to Thursday because of the expected snow and cold temperatures.
