## Boys advance to regional in nine events

OAK HABROR — Eastwood High School's boys track and field team added to its list of regional qualifiers Saturday afternoon. The Eagles qualified four additional individuals in five events, and one more relay team for the Division II regional during the final day of the district meet at Oak Harbor High School.

Eagle junior Noah Smith advanced in two individual events, finishing third in the 110 hurdles and fourth in the 200.

The Eagles' other individual qualifiers were seniors Cory Jay, who was second in the 1,600; Devin Good, who was second in the 800; and Jacob Meyer, who was third in the high jump.

Also advancing was the Eagles' fourth-place 4x100 relay team of junior Bryce Koprowski-Kistner, senior Jake Limes, sophomore Kaiden Sanchez and Smith.

The top four finishers in each event at the district qualified for the regional at Lexington High

School. The regional starts Thursday and concludes Saturday (May 28).

In all, the Eagles qualified 11 athletes in nine events for the regional.

The Eagles other regional qualifiers were junior Dalton Hesselbart in the pole vault; freshman Dayquan Oliver in the long jump; and the 4x800 relay team of Good, Jay, freshman Hayden Hoelter and senior Xander Ramsey.

Eastwood had only four regional qualifiers last season, all individuals and all in field events.

"We had a solid day," Eagle head coach Brian Sabo said. "In every event, we were at or better where we were Thursday. Nobody got worse. We're in a tough district. When you have to drop a lot of time or PR just to get out, that's tough to do." The Eagles finished fourth in the 13-team district with 89 points. Perkins won with 155, while Oak Harbor was second with 106 and Toledo Central Catholic was third with 89.

"I appreciate their effort," Sabo said. "We competed. I love this group. I'm proud of this team. We're still building. Our guys are going to look at the results from the other district, and be upset. But that's how you get better, running against good competition in our district."

Jay finished second in the 1,600 with a time of 4:40.94, a personal record to beat his previous best of 4:42.62.

Good was the runner-up in the 800 with a time of 2:04.62.

Meyer cleared 6-0 for third place in the high jump, and Smith was third in the 110 hurdles in 15.76. Smith also fourth in the 200 in 23.06.
