## Middle school girls, boys beat Woodmore

LUCKEY — Eastwood Middle School's girls and boys track and field teams posted victories over Woodmore on Thursday.

The girls won seven events in their 67-56 victory.

The boys had 13 first-place finishes in their 99-24 win.

Eastwood's Lilly Mullholand, Jordan Jensen and Leah Emch all won twice during the girls meet. Mullholand won the 400 in 1:08.79 and cleared 4-4 to win the high jump. Jensen swept the hurdles, winning the 100 race in 19.22 and the 200 race in 35.58. Emch won the 1,600 in 6:08.28 and the 800 in 2:49.39.

The Eagles' other winner was Taylor Spahn, who threw 63-9 to win the discus.

In the boys meet, Eastwood's Hayden Hoelter and Dayquan Oliver both won three events, and Andre Lewis won twice.

Hoelter won the 400 in 58.48 and the 200 in 26.83, and cleared 9-0 to win the pole vault. Oliver went 17-2 to win the long jump and 5-2 to win the high jump, and won the 100 in 12.74. Andre Lewis won both hurdles races, winning the 100 race in 17.67 and the 200 race in 28.57. The Eagles' other winners were: Hunter Lauer, shot put, 33-5½; and Braden Dix, discus, 116-6. Eastwood also won all three relays:

- 4x100, team of Parker Bengry, Kellan Miesmer, Wyatt Ashby and Logan Perry, 53.77.
- 4x200, team of Bengry, Zachary Mullholand, Ashby and Jason Young, 1:53.18.
- 4x400, team of Bengry, Eric Sander, Henry Howard and Jesse Poitry, 4:19.67.
