

## **Middle school girls finish fourth, boys fifth in Fassett Invitational**

OREGON — Eastwood Middle School's girls track and field team finished fourth and the boys were fifth Thursday (April 16) in the Fassett Invitational.

The girls scored 69 points to finish behind Washington (Whitmer) with 80½, Perrysburg 78 and Anthony Wayne 74½ in the 15-team meet.

The boys totaled 59½ points in their 16-team meet. Washington won with 98, followed by Briar (Perkins) 85, Perrysburg 83 and Anthony Wayne 77½.

The girls broke the school record in the 4x800 relay where Lorelei Dulaney, Madelaine Calmes, A'ryah Houtz and Kinsley Henline had a time of 11:01.84 to break the record of 11:02.10 set last season. The quartet finished fourth.

### **BOYS RECAP**

The Eagles won the 4x100 relay with Jackson Boninsegna, Avett Rollins-Morlock, Jaxsen Deanda and Vincent Opfer running a time of 48.75.

Opfer finished second in the 200 in 24.24, and the 4x800 relay team of Colton Miller, Carson Henline, Josh Finfera and Nicholas Agee was second in 9:45.97.

### **GIRLS RECAP**

Henline cleared 8-0 to win the pole vault, while Dulaney finished second with a height of 7-6.

The 4x400 team of Dulaney, Braylin Sheets, Henline and Sydney Sabo was second in 4:33.73.
