

## Girls, boys score Senior Day wins over Oak Harbor

LUCKEY — Eastwood High School's girls and boys track and field teams both defeated Oak Harbor in a Northern Buckeye Conference dual meet during the Eagles' Senior Day at Freedom Field.

The girls scored a 75-62 victory, while the boys were 71-66 winners. Eastwood won eight events in both meets.

The meet was held Wednesday after it was postponed Tuesday because of rain.

The Eagle seniors and their parents were recognized before the meet.

### GIRLS RECAP

Camille Foos won twice for the Eagles, who won four individual events and all four relays.

The freshman won the 400 in 1:03.30 and the high jump with a height of 5-0.

Also, for Eastwood, Z Ramsey won the 1,600 in 6:03.53 and junior Leah Emch won the 3,200 in 11:49.87.

The Eagles' winning relay teams were:

4x100: Kiefer, freshman Mallie Bradley, sophomore Piper Sutton and freshman Zurie Sanford, 56.30.

4x200: junior Mallory Sandberg, Kiefer, King and Might, 1:55.62.

4x800: Foos, Emch, Sponaugle and Ward, 10:11.92.

Eastwood sophomore Jenna Gallant broke her school record in the seated 100 with a time of 39.94. Her previous record of 40.14 came earlier this season.

## **BOYS RECAP**

Andre Lewis won twice for Eastwood, including a victory in the high jump that moved the junior into the school's all-time Top 10 in the event.

Lewis cleared 6-2 to move into a six-way tie for sixth place all-time.

He also won the 300 m hurdles in 41.68.

Sophomore Cullen Shark also moved into Eastwood's Top 10 in the pole vault by winning his specialty with a jump of 14-0. He's in a three-way tie for eighth place all-time.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: sophomore Henry Howard, 800, 2:10.09; and junior Dayquan Oliver, long jump, 20-8¼.

4x200: junior Jesse Poiry, Sanchez, and juniors Kevin Lewis and Wyatt Oestreich, 1:36.58.
