

Girls, boys win 5 events at Wauseon JV invitational

WAUSEON — Eastwood High School's track and field team combined to win five events Saturday at the junior varsity Wauseon Invitational.

The girls won three events and the boys won two. The girls also finished second in nine events and seven in five events. The boys added seven third third-place finishes.

No team scores were kept.

The Eagles won two individual events and one relay.

Keira Dawson broke the meet record in winning the 800. The freshman's time was 2:46.07 to break the record of 2:54.56 set last year.

Also for the Eagles, freshman Mallie Bradley won the 200 in 30.64, and the 4x800 relay team of seniors Jadyne Lubash and Maggie Ramsey,

freshman Mackenzie Chaffee and sophomore Caitlyn Stiner won in 11:47.57.

Eastwood's Brielle Konrad finished second in both hurdle races. The freshman had a time of 20.39 in the 100 race and 1:03.25 in the 300 race.
