

Middle school boys, girls defeat Fostoria

FOSTORIA — Eastwood Middle School's boys and girls track and field teams both defeated Fostoria Wednesday.

The boys won 14 of the 15 events in their 112-10 win, while the girls won 12 events on the way to an 88-35 victory.

Kevin Lewis won three events for Eastwood in the boys meet, and Andre Lewis, Dayquan Oliver both won twice.

Kevin Lewis won the 200 in 26.25, jumped 8-0 to win the pole vault and went 17-9½ to win the long jump. Andre Lewis won the 100 hurdles in 17.47 and the 200 hurdles in 27.58. Oliver won the 100 in 12.50 and cleared 5-2 to win the high jump.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: Austin Miller, 1,600, 5:54.05; Hayden Hoelter, 400, 59.94; A.J. Obrien, 800, 2:39.38; Hunter Lauer, shot put, 36-11¼.

Eastwood won three relays:

- 4x100, team of Parker Bengry, Kellan Miesmer, Logan Perry and Drew Luidhardt, 53.95.
- 4x200, team of Bengry, Miesmer, Zachary Mullholand and Jason Young, 1:57.03.
- 4x400, team of Ethan Goldsby, Eric Sander, Luidhardt and Miller, 4:26.85.

In the girls meet, the Eagles' Lilly Mullholand won three events, and Kyrie Henline won twice. Mullholand won the 400 in 1:07.87, the 200 in 30.14 and cleared 4-4 to win the high jump. Henline was first in the long jump, 13-9, and the pole vault, 7-0.

Eastwood's other individual winners were: Mallory Sandberg, 100 hurdles, 18.48; Emerson Sheets, 1,600, 6:31.58; Jordan Jensen, 200 hurdles, 34.20; Leah Emch, 800, 2:38.83; Mylie Frantz, shot put, 27-11; and Addison Hartman, discus, 85-0.

The Eagles' 4x400 relay team of Savannah Stephens, Jensen, Henline and Grace Meter won in 4:53.86.
