

Middle school girls, boys finish second at Clyde

CLYDE — Eastwood Middle School's girls and boys track and field teams both finished second in a four-team meet Monday to begin their seasons.

The girls won four events and scored 94.5 points, while McPherson won with 113, Monroeville was third with 17 and Willard was fourth with 7.5.

In the boys meet, Eastwood won three events and totaled 78 points. McPherson won with 129, while Monroeville was third with 17 and Willard was fourth with 10.

Eastwood's Josie Appelhans won three events in the girls meet. She won the 100 in 13.56, the 400 in 1:06.39 and the 200 in 27.45. Also for the Eagles, Camille Foos cleared 4-10 to win the high jump.

In the boys meet, Eastwood's Logan Miesmer threw 93-6 to win the discus and 35-11¼ to win the shot put. Also for the Eagles, Cam Shumaker won the 200 hurdles in 29.74.
