

Girls, boys defeat Lake in NBC dual meet

MILLBURY — Eastwood High School's girls and boys track and field teams both defeated Lake in a Northern Buckeye Conference dual meet Tuesday.

The girls won 14 of the 15 events on the way to a 132-17 victory. The boys won seven events in their 68-51 victory.

The pole vault and the high jump weren't held because of the wind.

GIRLS RECAP

Eastwood's Mallory Sandberg, Josie Appelhans and Leah Emch each won twice. Sandberg swept the hurdles, winning the 100 race in 16.8 and the 300 race in 52.7. Appelhans won the 100 in 13.6 and the 200 in 27.7. Emch won the 400 in 1:03.3 and the 3,200 in 12:33.7.

The Eagles' other individual winners were: Emily Payne, 1,600, 6:22.0; Camille Foos, 800, 2:36.5; Mylie Frantz, discus, 91-0; and Kennedy Ameling, shot put, 30-6½.

BOYS RECAP

The Eagles had three individual winners — Henry Howard in the 400, 54.5; Andre Lewis in the 300 hurdles, 40.2; and Dayquan Oliver in the 200, 23.1.

Lewis lowered his eighth-fastest time in history, his new personal record being 40.38 when his hand time of 40.2 was converted to FAT.
